

Xavier University of Louisiana Student Achievement

Xavier University of Louisiana identifies, evaluates, and publishes goals and outcomes for student achievement appropriate to the institution's mission, the nature of the students it serves, and the kinds of programs offered. Xavier uses multiple measures to document student achievement that include:

- **Freshman-**

acceptability measured by retention, graduation rates, graduate/professional performance on professional licensure examinations are the criteria utilized in the Strategic Plan with respect to student achievement. These thresholds are driven to optimize retention, graduation and post-graduate success and retention and identifies four measurable objectives:

• for new freshman retention rate, (75%);
 • for global graduation rates for undergraduates, (45%);
 • % of Arts & Sciences graduates attending, within two years, of a similar school as measured by the National Student Clearinghouse data, (national average); and

- Attain threshold of acceptability in pass rates for professional licensure examinations; These thresholds vary by program and are documented for our programs in counseling, education, pharmacy, physician assistant studies and speech language pathology in the Professional Licensure Examination Pass Rates section.

Xavier has set in place periodic evaluation of benchmark goals and objectives in its Strategic Plan. Student achievement is at the forefront of the institution's mission and a prime objective within the Strategic Plan.

While not specific objectives of the Strategic Plan, monitoring of student performance on other certification and licensure examinations are also identified as measures of student achievement at Xavier University of Louisiana.

Chart 3 - Six-Year Graduation Rate Recent Classes

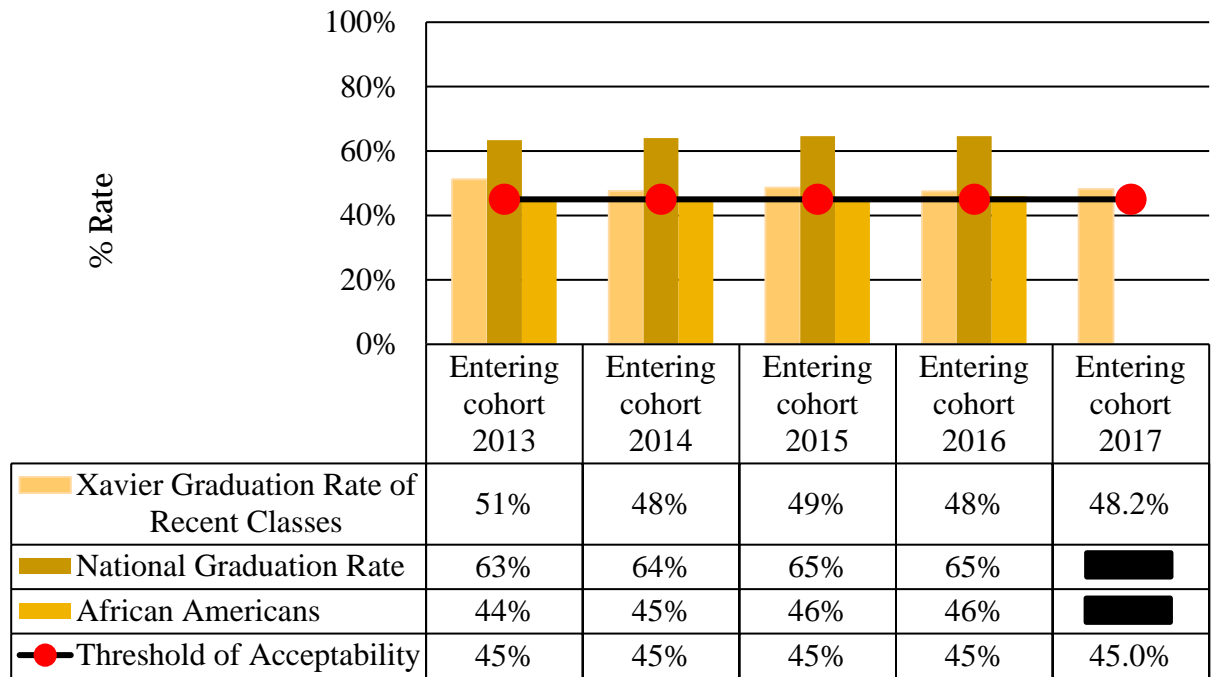
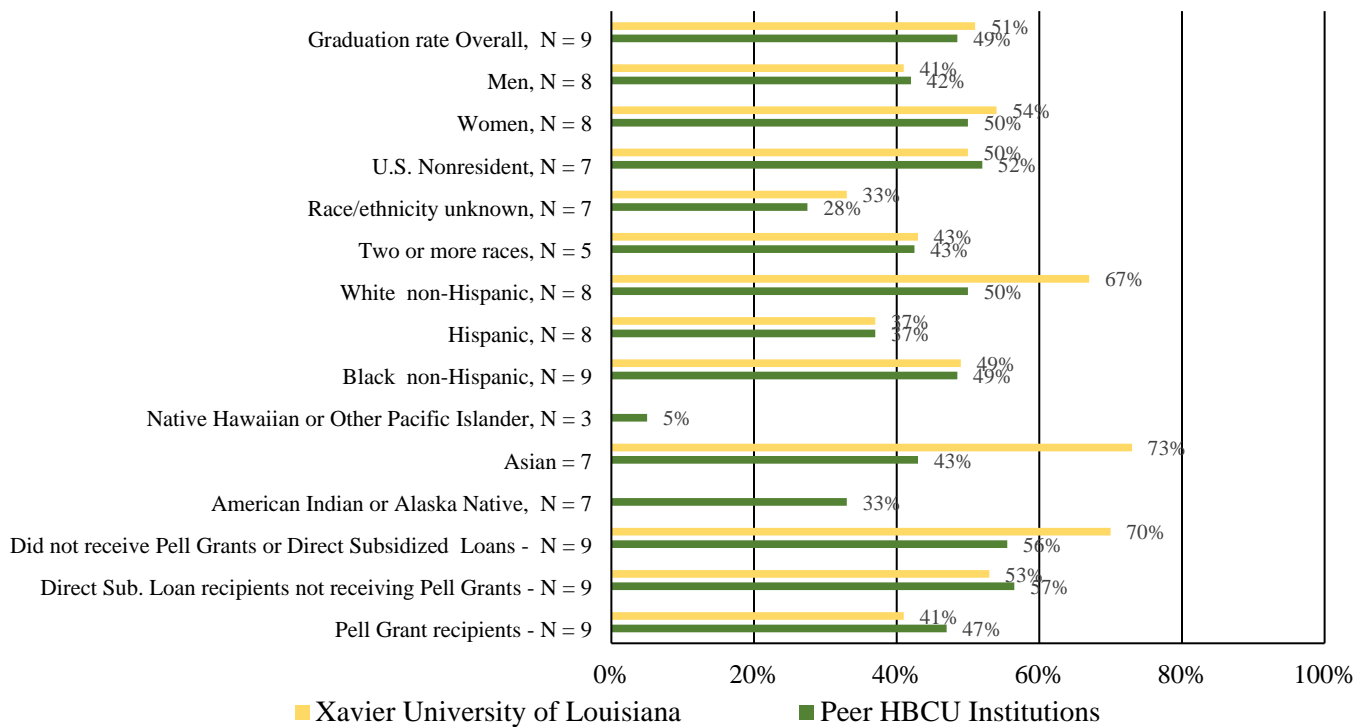

Speech-Language Pathology (SLP) Certifying Examination - Praxis Examination in Speech-Language Pathology

The Speech Language Pathology program began in Fall 2019. First-time pass rates of graduates are used as a measure of student achievement with the Xavier threshold based on the measure set by the program's accreditor, the Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (CAA) of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association.
