Applicants are encouraged to request their letters well before the deadline and to follow up with their recommenders before the deadline. Applicants can check the status of their letters in the XULA application portal.

Each applicant will be asked to record a brief video directly in the application portal. This video will allow you to tell us something about yourself that is not in your application, which will help us remember you and make you stand out. You will have two minutes to record your video and unlimited attempts

As part of a holistic application process, this video will not be screened during the initial review of applications; however, it will be seen once the candidate selection is made for interviews.

If you are an international student and English is not your first language, you must provide TOEFL or IELTS
